40 acres Camden Co. DeLorme 44, G-4

Directions: West from Macks Creek on US 54, then 2 miles south on MO 73.

When to Visit/Species to Expect: Check for nesting and migrating Pine Warblers, and in winter for Red-Breasted Nuthatch, Pine Siskins, crossbills and Evening Grosbeaks in invasion years.

Features of interest to birders: Mature stand of pines. Small pond. Fire tower is still open to the public. Pit toilet.

Nearby Birding Sites: Lead Mine CA, Berry Bluff CA, Mule Shoe CA
