

## A BIRDERS' GUIDE TO MISSOURI PUBLIC LANDS

### **PROCTOR TOWERSITE--UPDATED: 8/16/2008**

**115 acres, Morgan Co., Delorme 44, B-5**

Directions: From Versailles, go south on MO 5, then west (right) on Rt. J, then north (right) on MO 135 for three-quarters of a mile.

When to Visit/Species to Expect: Check for nesting and migrating Pine Warblers, and in winter for Red-Breasted Nuthatch, Pine Siskins, crossbills and Evening Grosbeaks in invasion years.

Features of interest to birders: Old two-track runs along the pines on the north side of the site, then into deciduous woods. Pit toilet.

Nearby Birding Sites: Gravois Mills Access, Hite Prairie CA, Shawnee Bend Access, Fiery Fork CA, Climax Springs Towersite
