Directions: From US 50 in southeast Sedalia, go 11 miles southeast on Rt. M

When to Visit/Species to Expect: Anytime. Expect a normal array of species for the season, habitats and vicinity

Features of interest to birders: A one-acre pond/lake may harbor waterfowl.

The quarter-mile walk from the parking area to the impoundment goes past some dense shrubs, woods and grassland.

Narrow paths through the area provide access into woods and grasses and to Lake Creek that crosses the southeast corner of the area.
